Disclaimer for Hunter Douglas Vignette ® Modern Roman Shades

Vignette ® Modern Roman Shades have inherent characteristics that every buyer should know before purchasing.

Minimum Edge Light Gaps, All Inside Mount Applications (from window opening edge to fabric)

- Control Side - 5/8"
- Free Side - 1/2"

Due to variations in dry-walled window openings, the Edge Gaps will vary depending on the degree of variation of the window opening.

Shade Assembly – the shade shall be manufactured and hung to be level, within 1/8".

Sill Depth – The material on a Vignette rolls off the front of the roller tube assembly. For window sills that have a net sill depth less than 3 1/2", it will appear that the fabric hangs out of the window opening while the shade is being lowered. Once the shade is fully lowered, continue pulling on the front cord so that the shade will shift back towards the glass, within 7/8" of the mounting surface. This action will shift the material so that it will hang inside the window opening (on windows that have a net sill depth less than 3 1/2").

Multi-Panel Shades

For shades ordered wider than the available width of the fabric, a multi panel shade can be ordered. The gap between fabric panels will be approximately 1/8". See "Size Standards Chart" to determine if a multi-panel shade is necessary.
